Challenge

Besides supporting the city's main administrative offices, the network and computers for the City of Fresno are vital for critical services from the police and fire departments. A few years ago, when a lot of spyware and viruses were making it onto desktop systems, IT realized that the in-place security solutions were not doing their job. Administration was also increasingly difficult and time-consuming.

While diagnosing the problem, IT found that many of the threats originated on websites and first tried another web security product. Unfortunately, this product not only failed to stop the threats but also increased the complexity of managing yet another security product. At this point, the City evaluated several products from leading security vendors. Web security was the major requirement, but there were other constraints. “Our situation was especially challenging since we have many remote sites, where network bandwidth is limited,” said Jeremy Mello, network systems specialist for the City of Fresno. “Cost is always a big factor. We are a local government with limited resources and restricted budgets. We need a solution that can affordably extend protection to all of the remote sites as well as both of our main Internet gateways.”

Since the City is in the process of implementing online credit card payments, compliance with Payment Card Industry (PCI) and other applicable regulations was also taken into consideration during the evaluation process.

Solution

“We evaluated several alternatives and found that Trend Micro Enterprise Security does everything we want it to do—we are happy that we switched to Trend Micro,” said Mello.

A combination of endpoint, messaging, and web security solutions will let the City build in multiple layers of protection from the latest threats. Trend Micro Enterprise Security products and services are powered by the Trend Micro Smart Protection Network infrastructure—a next-generation cloud-client innovation that combines sophisticated cloud-based reputation technology, feedback loops, and the expertise of TrendLabsSM researchers to deliver real-time protection from emerging threats.

“The introduction of Trend Micro Enterprise Security will definitely be a big improvement for us,” said Mello. “Smart Protection Network takes a lot of security overhead off of our PCs and servers. With our previous security solutions, and their large pattern files and updates, that was a big problem and one of the main things that led to our choice to change vendors. Rather than all clients querying Trend Micro threat intelligence in the cloud, we can designate a Smart Protection server on premise to mirror that intelligence

and support local clients. We can deploy as many of the Smart Protection servers as we need—this is a very scalable solution for us, and it doesn't compromise bandwidth efficiency for our Internet connections either."

The City is also introducing another Trend Micro Enterprise Security solution, Trend Micro™ InterScan™ Web Security Virtual Appliance, to increase protection from web threats.

"InterScan Web Security Virtual Appliance is an effective way to meet a major security objective—to stop web threats and to prevent the spread of threats in our network," said Mello. "With an integrated cache, InterScan Web Security Virtual Appliance will also increase performance and give our users better web experiences. This new feature reduces processing on desktops, and doesn't take up any resources on those systems it protects."

During its testing of the newest version of InterScan Web Security Virtual Appliance, IT identified many of its features that will further strengthen the City's overall web security. "URL Filtering Warning Mode will help me automate some functions and minimize IT involvement, and the Deployment Wizard also helps me streamline setup," said Mello. "These and other InterScan Web Security Virtual Appliance enhancements—like the LDAP user identification enhancement—are really going to help us a lot."
